Requirements for technical college: you must be 18 years or older and have interest in a certain program/job.

How to Apply

- Choose a Vocational School
 - Think about what job you want to have.
 - Research various vocational schools you are interested in and what specific programs they offer that would help you in your desired job.
 - Research prerequisites, tuition, and financial aid opportunities.
- Prepare your application
 - Look on the school's website for the course calendar from the department you are interested in. See what prerequisites you need in order to be considered
 - Fill out a basic application online (name, address, high school grad date, etc.)
 - Inquire about financial aid opportunities at the vocational school if you need help paying for it.
 - Meet with an admission representative from the school and be sure to ask lots of questions and take notes.
- Submit your application
 - Be sure your application is complete, on time to meet any deadlines, and well done.
 - The website or admissions representative should be able to tell you when you can expect to begin your course.
 - Be sure to pay your deposit and secure your spot.
- Begin your program
 - If you need to do any tests or purchase any special equipment or

clothing, be sure to do that before your program starts.

- Do your very best in every aspect of your program, from the very first day, so that you can receive excellent recommendations for future jobs. Every person you meet is capable of telling others about the good work that you do, so always give your all. Also prepare to investigate whether or not it's a good idea for you to get any additional certifications or education, in order to advance in your career. Make a plan.
